Base Tuition for the School Year:	Amount
5 Day Pre-Kindergarten 8:18 - noon	\$3,300
5 Day Pre-Kindergarten full day	\$5,300
Kindergarten through 5 th Grade	\$7,250
6 th Grade through 8 th Grade	\$7,750
9 th Grade through 12 th Grade	\$8,950
Tuition includes textbooks, technology fees, student planners, and science lab fees. Students may be required to purchase paperback novels occasionally.	

Sibling Discount: Sibling discounts apply to full-time students only. A **sibling discount** of **10%** of the base tuition will be applied for the second highest full-time tuition. A **sibling discount** of **12%** of the base tuition will be applied for the third highest full-time tuition. A **sibling discount** of **15%** of the base tuition will be applied for the fourth and additional full-time tuition. There is no sibling discount applied to Pre-Kindergarten students.

Annual Payment Discount:
The discount for **annual payment** due on July 1, 2008 is \$50 per family. The discount is not available for families who receive tuition assistance or to Pre-Kindergarten students.

Waived discounts are charitable contributions.

*All fees are nonrefundable except as noted above. Office processing, seat deposit, and testing fees are due at enrollment or reenrollment.

**All students must be in a supervised program before and after school hours (either AM/PM Care, Extended Day, Athletics, or Drama).

Part-time students are invited to apply for admission. The fee structure is as follows:

The first class is 25% of tuition. Each additional class (second through sixth class) is 15% of tuition. **In order to participate in extracurricular activities or benefit from extra educational services**, students must take three or more classes, two of which must be CORE classes (English, Science, History, Math, Bible, Computer).

Williamsburg Christian Academy reserves the right to suspend educational services, the administering of exams, and the issuing of grades if an account is delinquent. Once an academic quarter has started, tuition and fees are due for the entire quarter. A late fee of \$25.00 per month is assessed to delinquent accounts.
